Parents are walking into bedrooms, finding their child gone forever.

Mothers are left staring at unopened text messages, praying for a reply that will never come.

"I still text my son's phone, hoping just once he'll answer."

The Pain of a Mother's Grief

1 in 3 families in America is devastated by addiction.

Millions of children wake up every day wondering if today will be the day their parent doesn't come home.

More than 2.7 million children have a parent battling substance use disorder, living in fear and uncertainty

"I found my daughter on her bedroom floor, cold and lifeless. I held her in my arms, but I was too late."

Overdose Deaths – Lives Stolen Too Soon

In 2022 alone, over 100,306 people died from a drug overdose.

That's 275 lives lost every single day.

That's 11 deaths every hour

That's a child, a mother, a father gone.

"They told me my son was just 'experimenting.' The next time, he never woke up."



Fentanyl is now the leading cause of death for Americans aged 18-45.

A single pill, laced with fentanyl, can take a life in seconds.

Too many parents have gone to wake their child in the morning, only to find they never woke up.

"I kissed my daughter goodnight, not knowing it would be the last time I'd ever see her alive."

Our Programs

Individual Counseling

Our individual counseling provides personalized support and guidance, addressing each mother's unique journey with compassion and care. Through tailored strategies, we foster healing, resilience, and empowerment.



Support Groups

Support groups provide mothers with essential resources, education, and training on addiction recovery, parenting, and financial stability, fostering strength, connection, and lasting empowerment.

Educational Workshops

Educational workshops, such as the National Awareness March, highlight the challenges mothers face, fostering awareness and understanding while advocating for support and resources for those affected by addiction.

Advocacy & Awareness

Advocacy and awareness initiatives provide a safe space for mothers to connect, share their struggles, and find hope, empowering them with the support they need to navigate their journey.

Proposed Initiatives for 2025

Double Organizational Size

Expand to 12 regional chapters, enabling us to extend our reach and offer support to more mothers across the nation.

Increase Counseling Hours

Increase counseling availability by adding 100 hours per week, bringing our total to 150 hours of counseling each week to better support those in need.



National Awareness March

Organize a large-scale awareness march to raise public consciousness about the profound impact of addiction on mothers and their families.

Supporting Team Expansion

Create 10 new support staff positions to strengthen our operational efficiency and improve the delivery of our programs.



Some days, I feel like I can't go on. But then I remember the support I have at MAA. Just knowing there are others who care keeps me moving forward.


MAA doesn't just talk about making a difference, they actually do. The impact they have on families is real, and I'm honored to be part of it.




